1) Organizer:

MOD (Command Mountain battle) and the NCO Society Tirol (UOGT)

2) Type of shooting:

Team Shooting Competition = 3 people-all 3 shooters will be counted. The team has to appear completely to the competition!

2.1) Weapons and Ammunition:

Assault rifle 77 (AUG 77) und Pi80, all weapons are provided by the organizer. Own weapons and ammunition are not allowed

2.2) Targets:

10 Ring discs,
Electronic scoring

2.3) Conditions:

a) STG 77

- Lying and hanging up
- Distance 200 m
- 3 Shot Test – time 1 minute
- 10 Shot Rating – time 3 minutes
- Fire: Single Fire
- The team must complete the competition.

2.4) Pistol Shooting/Team

Pistol 80 (PI 80) on 3 stands

- 5 rounds per participant
- All 5 rounds are counted

5) Organisation:

7) Shooting start:

7. September 2018, um 1300 Uhr,
8. September 2018, um 0800 Uhr

8) Participants:

- a) Federal Army: Soldiers and members of the militia
- b) Police teams, Justice guards, customs, fire brigades and rescue organizations
- c) Teams of traditional associations and civilian teams
- d) Foreign teams

Important Note

According to the order of the Ministry of Defence, only persons from the age of 21 can participate in the shooting. In accordance with the Weapons Act (I.d.gF) § 12 and § 13, no weapons ban may be imposed on the notified, or proceedings must be pending!:

9) Suit and adjusting:

Federal Army: General Service suit;
Foreign teams: Uniform for active and reservists according to national regulations;
Executive: Clothing exempt, uniform like seen;
Traditional associations and civil teams:
Uniform, costume, civil clothing;

10) Arbitration Court:

1 Main Referee: posed by the organization
2 Referee: These are chosen or determined by the Teamleaders

11) Rating:

Electronic scoring; Ring 1 – 10 rings;
The scoring is based on the sum of the rings of the entire team

12) Weapon Error

The entire passage must be repeated with another weapon. Decision on repetition meets the competition leader immediately.

13) Security measures:

Non-shooting participants (other than functional personnel) will stay outside the shooting hall until they are called by the competition leader.

It may only be shot with ear guards, these are located at the stand.

Private hearing protection brackets are allowed.

The instructions of the supervisory and management staff, marked with yellow, red, blue and white armbands, must be guaranteed.

Before shooting, a strictly alcohol ban is valid! In case of infringement, even individual shooters, the entire team can be excluded.

14) Bans:

- Use of special shooting glasses and eye flaps
- Eyeglass wearers may only use the spectacles of daily use
- Shooting Vests

15) Protests:

In the event of a weapon error, it is possible to day immediately, otherwise in writing until one hour after the announcement of the results on the notice, but not later than 1600 o'clock of the competition against Deposit of Euro 15.00 only by the team leader.

In case of justified protest, the opposition fee is paid back.

16) Award Ceremony:

The award ceremony will take place on the **8th September 2018**, approximately 1 hour after the end of the shooting, directly at the shooting range.

17) Prices:

1. overall ranking Stg77 + Pi80 team
2. 1st to 3rd place ladies and gentlemen
3. Day winner

16) Adjusting for the award ceremony:

- Executive and Austrian Army: Uniform output
- For foreign participants: Service Suit (basic form)
- Traditional associations and civilian participants: Uniform, costume, social suit

17) Catering:

All participants will receive a goulash with bread on the day of the shooting from 1100 a.m. to 1330 o'clock. Schützenstüberl Open all day.

20) Accommodation:

Accommodation in the barracks for foreign participants cannot be granted;

Reservations for private accommodation cannot be made for organizational reasons.

21) General:

The nomination of a participant for several teams is not permitted!

Each participant participates in this competition at his own risk and bears the civil and criminal responsibility for all harmful-material damages.

By submitting the application, the above-mentioned conditions are regarded as recognised!

Any changes are reserved for the organise!

The teams are requested to comply with the Start times according to planning in order to avoid greater waiting times!

We ask for the formation of Car pools due to the parking situation on site!

The provisional starting list will be displayed about 1 week before the event on the homepage of the UOGT (www.uogt.at) published.

Information on the Basic Data Protection Regulation:

The persons, which named in the entry form, are agree with the procedure of personal data processing, by the UOGT, concerning the registered persons, as follows:

The data provided by the participants in the registration form will be processed for the following purposes:

- Creation and publication of the start and result lists.

Furthermore, by submitting the application, the consent is given, that pictures of the participants, which were produced during the event, will be published in the newsletter and on the homepage of the UOGT.

With submission of the entry for shooting is also noted that

- the above consents can be revoked in whole or in part, by the participants at any time
- has the right to receive information about the processing of personal data concerning participants at any time,
- there is a possibility of requesting the correction of this data, or a restriction of its processing, as well as the deletion of the data.
